

Seasoning Salt Love is the Spice of Life

Spice jars from SpecialtyBottle.com or see the other example below Labels (see website for template) Measuring cups and ½ teaspoon Funnel Sea Salt Chili Powder

Ground Coriander Garlic Powder

Ground Mustard
Onion Powder

Ground Paprika

Ground Pepper (black or white)

Note: feel free to use all spices above or not. Also add others spices if you like; keeping the sea salt as the base.

To start, each 4 oz spice jar will hold exactly 1/2 cup of 'love spice'... the recipe is as follows:

- 1. a little less than 1/2 cup of salt set aside
- 2. Measure 1/2 teaspoon of each spice (chili powder, ground coriander, garlic powder, ground mustard, onion powder, ground paprika + ground pepper).
- 3. Once all seven spices are measured, thoroughly mix them together
- 4. Then add your spice mix into the salt and completely blend them together.
- 5. Using a funnel carefully pour your homemade seasoning salt into your spice jar.
- 6. Next pop the lid on the jar
- 7. Lab the jar with your super cute lab

Note: You can make this recipe in single batches or in a large batch. Make it your own and be a little crazy. Nothing like making something yourself and being on the receiving end of something homemade.
